

ROUTES

with gulet BLUE NOSE

The routes in this document use only as suggestions and can be modified according to your wishes and interests. During the cruising on gulet BLUE NOSE the routes can be modified, stay at some places can be prolonged and visits to some places can be canceled, etc. It is also important to know that some itineraries depend also on the weather conditions.

During the night the boat can be anchored in marina / harbor or in secluded bay. The nights in City harbors and marinas are all charged (additional payment, not included in the price per lease / per week). During the July or August there might not be free room in marinas if ship comes in too late in the day. During September there is less crowd in marinas.

Since gulet BLUE NOSE is bigger and stable boat it will not rock even if there is a bit of wind or waves outside so boat can sleep over in some secluded bays – hundreds of great bays all over islands in Adriatic. Sleep over in secluded bay is free.

The best places to visit are also national parks like Kornati islands, River Krka Waterfalls, Mljet Island. The entrance fee to national park is around 10-15 EUR / per person, group discounts are possible.

Since Adriatic coast is too big to see it all in one week there are few decisions for the clients need to make. Decisions like what part you want to see, would you like to see nature or visit towns and villages, do you want to take it slow and easy, spend more times in secluded bays and have fun in water, or sacrifice your time and take bigger and longer rides to cover more space and visit more things but spend less time there.

Route 1: CENTRAL ADRIATIC

This route is designed to cover Kornati islands – group of thousands of smaller and bigger islands. It is beautiful untouched nature accessible only for people with ships, since there is no towns villages or any hotels on it. Only people with boats get to spend nights there. This route includes visit to Zadar. It is a city with old city center, city walls and medieval structures. In this route you get to ride up the river Krka to the lake and Krka Waterfalls. This route will take of about 4 hours a day of riding, so there will be lot of time to enjoy.

Route 1: CENTRAL ADRIATIC



SATURDAY:

Check-in in Trogir (around 17.00h)

SUNDAY:

Cruise from Trogir to Zirje Island.

MONDAY:

Cruise to Zut Island. This is Kornati Islands National Park area. Possible sleep over in Telascica Bay.

TUESDAY:

Cruise around northern side of Ugljan Island to city of Zadar.

WEDNESDAY:

Cruise to Murter Island.

THURSDAY:

Sail into Sibenik bay, and up the river into national park Krka to the waterfalls.

FRIDAY:

Cruise to Drvenik Island

SATURDAY:

Sail to Trogir – Check out till 12.00h

Route 2: SOUTHERN ADRIATIC

This route covers all the best places in southern Adriatic. You get to visit most distanced inhabited islands on Adriatic (Vis island). Also this is great scenery, but here you get to visit some old towns like Vela luka on Korcula Island, city Hvar on Hvar island, city Komiza on Vis island. This route will also take 4 hours of riding a day – a lot of time to relax.

Route 2: SOUTHERN ADRIATIC



SATURDAY

Check-in in Trogir (around 17.00h)

SUNDAY

Cruise to Brač Island (Bay Milna)

MONDAY

Cruise to Hvar Island, and to Pakleni Islands on western side of Hvar.

TUESDAY

Cruise to Vis Island (town Vis or Komiza)

WEDNESDAY

Cruise to Lastovo Island

THURSDAY

Cruise to Korcula Island (to town Vela Luka)

FRIDAY

Cruise to Drvenik

SATURDAY

Cruise to Trogir and check – out till 12.00h

Route 3: SOUTHERN ADRIATIC including DUBROVNIK

This route will take you further south. You get to visit Mljet Island which is national park, and city of Dubrovnik. This route will take at least 6 hours of cruising, you get to cover more ground but with more cruising, especially on the way back.

Important remark. Route 3 – SOUTHERN ADRIATIC including DUBROVNIK is here only informatively described. We (Agency Mare Ltd.) have a right to modify the Route 3 according to the CAPTAIN suggestions and his evaluation of the weather and seasonal characteristics of certain destinations. It can be modified on different itineraries but in all modifications the route includes visiting Dubrovnik.

Route 3 described below is the best and optimal route if all other conditions are implemented.

Route 3: SOUTHERN ADRIATIC including DUBROVNIK



SATURDAY

Check-in in Trogir (around 17.00h)

SUNDAY-

Cruise to Hvar Island and to Pakleni Islands on western side of Hvar.

MONDAY

Cruise to Orebič on Pelješac.

TUESDAY

Cruise to Mljet Island

WEDNESDAY

Cruise to Dubrovnik

THURSDAY

Cruise to town Vela Luka on Korčula Island

FRIDAY

Cruise to Drvenik Island

SATURDAY

Cruise to Trogir and check – out till 12.00h
